

The workshop marks the launch of the eBL platform. With over 300,000 lines of text, most of them previously unpublished, the launch represents the largest text publication in the history of cuneiform studies. Many of these texts are still unidentified and it is hoped that the public launch will enable other users to identify and use them for their work. In addition, full electronic editions of notable texts such as the Epic of Creation and the Gilgamesh Epic will be released on this day. Moreover, a complete sign list and an Akkadian dictionary will also be made fully available to the public. Join us at this event.


